Hello,

If someone is receiving Medicare but they continue to work, the first \$65 of their earned income is not counted, or disregarded. Only half of the remaining earned income is counted towards eligibility for MSP. However, if their spouse works and is not yet on Medicare, the total amount of their spouse's earned amount is considered for eligibility.
