For State Supplement, ABLE accounts are treated the same that they are treated for SSI. Information on how it is treated for SSI can be found here: [SPOTLIGHT ON ACHIEVING A BETTER LIFE EXPERIENCE \(ABLE\) ACCOUNTS \(ssa.gov\)](#)

Basically, the first \$100,000 of the balance is excluded as an asset, anything in excess of \$100,000 does count as an asset.

It will take some time to have UPM updated, but [Public Act 22-140](#) outlines it on page 12.
