As we discussed on the phone, I'm hoping to confirm that it is current Department policy to treat same sex married couples the same as heterosexual couples with regard to the T19 qualification, in particular the asset and income limitations. That is, should either spouse required T19 benefits, an assessment of combined spousal assets will first be completed. Where necessary, a spend down of excess assets will be required regardless of title ownership.
